## Q: What's your crime?



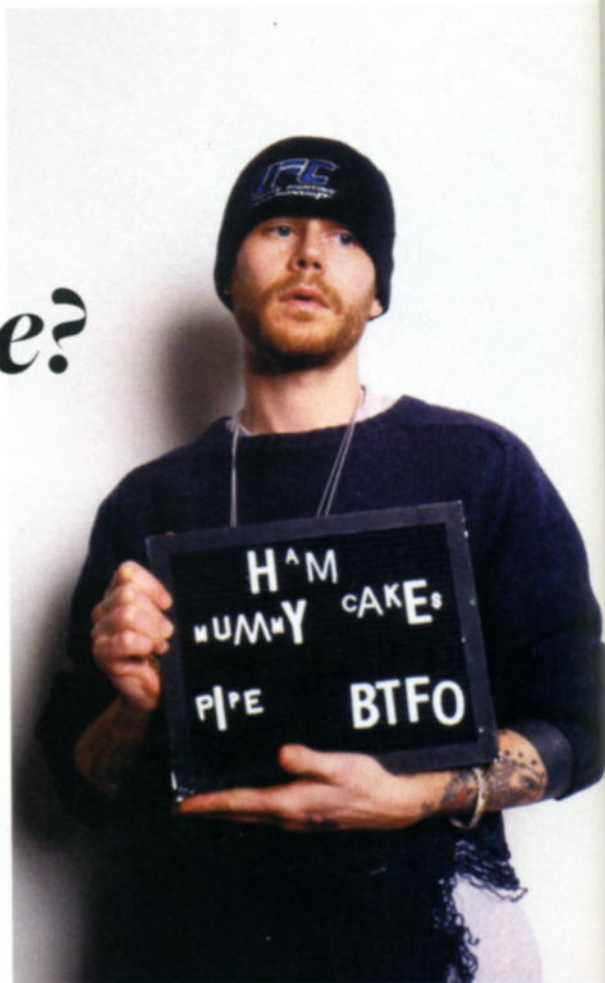
*"Making an effort to do laundry, then leaving my clothes in the dryer for a week."*
